Awards Committee
2017 Award Guidelines

PHL Official Championship Trophy

Awarded to the seasons championship winners as determined by playoffs. All Champions receive a plaque on the trophy and each of the team members is allowed to keep the trophy in their possession for a 6 months time span.

Individual Champion Trophy

Awarded to the seasons championship winners as determined by playoffs for each individual team member to keep.

Championship Jacket

Awarded to the seasons championship winners as determined by the playoffs. The jacket should contain the league name, year, players name and players team. The jackets for both players should be the same type and style. Jackets should not contain offensive material as it reflects the Horseshoe league when seen in public. Additional information can be added to jackets for repeat winners as opposed to supplying an additional jacket.

Best Regular Season Record

Awarded to the team with the best overall regular season record at the end of the regular season. Head to head matchup, then total team points, and finally head to head points determines tiebreakers for the season.

Conference Champion

Awarded to the team with the highest standing in their respective conference.

Scoring Champion

Awarded to player with the highest PPG Avg. – Must have played at least 75% of the season or more in order to qualify. In the event that there is a difference in total points and PPG, the board may approve a secondary “Total Points” award.

Cas Santos Ringer Champion

Awarded to player with the highest RPG Avg. – Must have played at least 75% of the season or more in order to qualify.

Pat Dooley Singles Champion

Awarded to player with the highest SPG Avg. – Must have played at least 75% of the season or more in order to qualify.

Doubles Champion

Awarded to player with the highest DbPG Avg. – Must have played at least 75% of the season or more in order to qualify.

Triple Crown Award

In the event that a single player wins all three of the scoring champion, ringer champion and doubles champion awards the committee can give the players one larger trophy to reflect all three awards instead of 3 individual awards.

Most Improved

Awarded to the player with the most improvement (PPG Increase and PPG % increase) from the end of the previous season to the end of the current season. Veterans playing more than 2 seasons should have increases calculated against the highest single season average of their career.

Best B Player

Awarded to the B player with the highest PPG. Must play at least 75% of the season to qualify. Tiebreaker goes to highest RPG and then total points scored.

Rookie of the Year

Awarded to the rookie with highest PPG. Must play at least 75% of the season to qualify. Tiebreaker goes to highest RPG and then total points scored.

Hall of Fame Award

To be given to that years Hall of Fame inductees. All Hall of Fame awards should follow the same traditional style of a crystal pillar with the league name, members name and enshrinement year engraved.

Records

When new league records are set the committee should recognize those achievements with certificates to commemorate the record during the award ceremony.

Guidelines have been created by the 2017 official Pegasus Horseshoe League committee to "guild" future members in selection of awards and to bring transparency to the process of selecting the recipients. The official awards committee reserves the right to update or veer from the guidelines if deemed necessary.
